

## VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION

**Volunteer Project/Opportunity Title:** *Plant ID Interpretive Signage Designer*

**Description of Duties/Project:** We are looking to produce approximately 40 interpretive signs which will identify different plants in a native plant garden at Lost River (Woodstock, NH). The signs will display color photographs of specific parts of each plant (fruit, flower, bark, leaf, etc) and will be approximately 6"x 9" in dimension. They will be printed on weatherproof plastic and installed near the appropriate plants in the garden. We are looking for someone to coordinate design and production of these signs, which will be seen by thousands of people visiting Lost River annually!

Duties will involve collating digital photographs of native plants, creating a template for the plant signs in a desktop publishing or graphic design program (your choice), arranging the layout of each plant sign, and producing a final document for each sign that can be sent to a professional printer.

**Time Commitment /Hours:**

As needed/flexible, now through May 2012.

**Preferred Qualifications:** Experience with a desktop publishing or graphic design program (Publisher, Scribus, PagePlus, Inkscape, etc.) in which you will be able to design the signage; a good eye for design; knowledge of native plants helpful but not absolutely necessary; experience working with digital photo files (cropping, etc). Personal laptop or home computer is needed also if you are not able to drive to Concord!

**Worksite:**

Flexible. Can be done from volunteer's home computer, or at Conservation Center in Concord.
