We look forward to another season of our conservation partnership with you and hope to see you in Concord at the landowner gathering on April 9th!



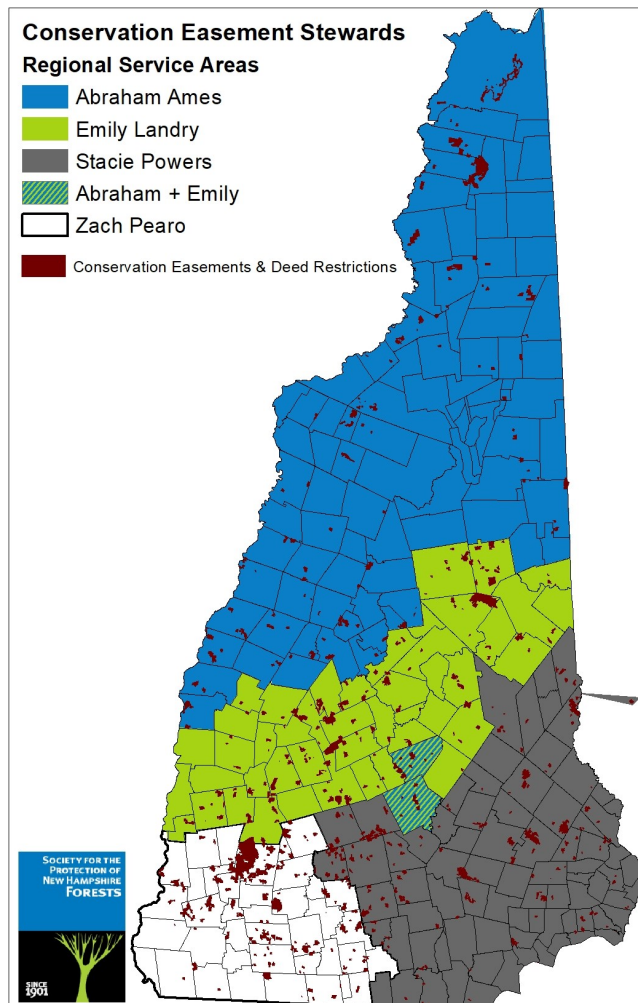
